In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833;

Watson A Fox of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Elijah R. [redacted] of Buffalo New York are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the Ansel R Cobb whereof Watson A Fox is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio in the year 1844 as appears by her enrollment dated at the Port of Cleveland Ohio April 23. 1846 & numbered 1171 Seventeen and now surrendered having changed owners

And the said enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is one hundred and seven feet and three inches her breadth is twenty three feet and eleven inches her depth is nine feet and eight inches and that she measures two hundred and twenty six tons and seven ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig and has a square Stern and a Scull head

And the said Watson A Fox having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
