1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern,
Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,
passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of
passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the
President whereof *W. C. Hoag*
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River*
Ohio in the year 1844 as appears by the Enrollment dated
at this port June 13th 1845 ~~and having changed~~ having changed
owner, and new papers issued, as authorized by the Secretary of
the Treasury Letter dated June 11. 1849
And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or Vessel has *One deck* and *two masts* and that
her length is *Eighty six feet* and *two inches* *86, 10*
her breadth *Twenty feet* and *three inches* *20, 3*
her depth *Eight feet* and *nine inches* *8, 9*
and that she measures *One hundred thirty nine* tons *thirty three* ninety-fifths;
that she is a Schooner has *No gallies*
and a *single* head

And the said *William Ward* having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
