is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Rochester New York*, in the year *1844* as appears by the Certificate of *W. H. Howell*, Shipwright, dated at *Rochester, N. Y.*, June 16, 1849, now on file in this office,

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Canal Boat or Vessel has *One Deck* and her length is *seventy eight feet and three inches* and that her breadth is *fourteen feet and three inches* and her depth *five feet* and that she measures *Fifty Two* tons *Twenty Six* and that she is a *Canal Boat* has a *Square Stern* and head

And the said *head* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat, has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
