In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

William Dickson, of Buffalo, New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with *Crastus B. Seymour,*

and *William Wells, of Buffalo, New York,*

Citizen of the United States, <sup>and</sup> ~~is~~ sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel, called the *Illinois* whereof *William Dickson*

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo New York* in the year 1849 as appears by the Certificate of *Jacob*

*W. Banta, Master Builder, dated 14th day of August, 1849, now on file in this office*

And *Charles M. Hopkins (Surveyor)* having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has *One Deck* and *One Mast*, and that her length is *One hundred and eighty two feet* her breadth *Twenty seven feet and eight inches* her depth *Seven feet* and that she measures *Five hundred thirty tons and fifty five* that she is a *Propeller* <sup>has</sup> *ninety-fifths;*

And the said *William Dickson* <sup>and</sup> *William Wells* <sup>head</sup> having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Propeller* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
