Murch dated in the year 18 as appears by the Certificate of Paul filed in this Office.

And she chartered to Richard Simpson having certified that the said Coral Boat or Vessel has her length is Twenty Nine feet and that her breadth Fourteen feet and one inch and her depth Five feet and six inches and that she measures fifty seven tons Sixty ninety-fifths; that she is a Coral Boat and head

And the said Samuel S. Murch and having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Coral Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
