In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

John Eason of Parcelman New P.M.,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Orin whereof William Van Arman

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Erie Penn. in the year 1848 ^{and rebuilt} in the year 1848 as appears by the keel of said Vessel. Made by Wm. W. Gallagher Collector Erie Pa. dated July 31st 1849.

And Richard Dilling Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Mast and two Masts and that her length is Sixty feet 60 feet her breadth Eighteen feet 18 " her depth Six feet and Nine inches 6 " 9." and that she measures Sixty two tons Eighty eight ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner and has a Stern head

And the said John Eason having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
