In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833,

John F. Stafford of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Charles J. McGill of Buffalo N.Y.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the Boston of Buffalo, whereof Charles McGill is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1842 as appears by the Enrollment dated

at this port July 6th 1849. and amended twenty five New amended having changed names

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Ninety One feet and two inches 91 ft 2 in her breadth Twenty Three feet and two inches 23 ft 2 in her depth Eight feet Nine and one half inches 8 ft 9 1/2 in and that she measures One hundred and twenty five tons Seventy five ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig " " has

And the said John F. Stafford and Charles McGill head agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
