and that she measures Two hundred twenty three tons Twenty five ninety-fifths;

that she is a Schooner and has a screw head

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been

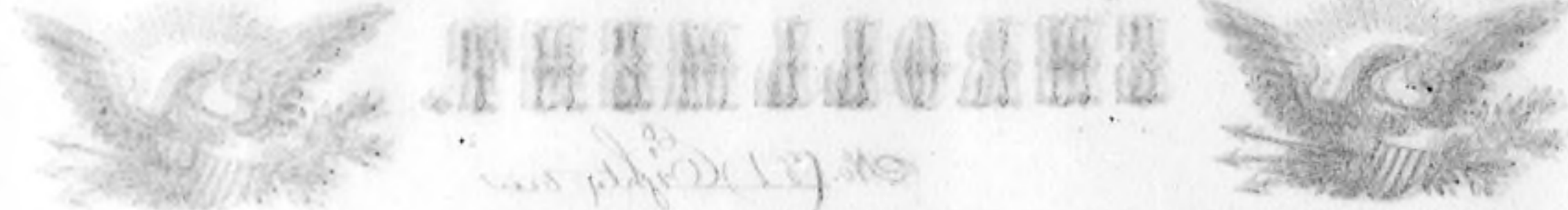
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly
