In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with John R. Wheeler of Buffalo N.Y.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the *Marion* whereof Inail J. Palmer is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio in the year 1841 as appears by Her Enrollment

dated at this port November 14. th 1846. and Numbered (77) Now Individual having changed owners,

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and two Masts and that her length is Eighty two feet and six inches 82 ft 6 in her breadth Twenty feet and five inches 20 ft 5 in her depth Nine feet and four inches 9 ft 4 in and that she measures One hundred and Forty tons Eighty six ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has

And the said Wiram Niles and a crew head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
