In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

Conrad A. Fenwick, of Buffalo, New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with

Samuel H. Measer, of Buffalo, New York, and James Britton, of

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel, called the "Windsor" whereof Abram Britton,

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Irving crew mo in the year 1847 as appears by Enrollment, dated

at this port, the 16th day of March, 1848, and numbered six (6) now amended, having changed owners

And the said Enrollment, having certified that

the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts, and that

her length is One hundred and fifteen feet and seven inches 114 feet 7 in

her breadth Twenty five feet and one inch 25 " 1 "

her depth Ten feet and Three inches 10 " 3 "

and that she measures Two hundred sixty nine tons & thirty five ninety-fifths;

that she is a Schooner and a Stern Head

And the said Conrad A. Fenwick having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been

given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly

Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
