In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

Lucian M. Smith of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he  
together with the Estate of William Hollister of  
Buffalo New York

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel, called the  
Propeller Hercules - whereof D. Alexander  
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo  
New York in the year 1843 as appears by the Enrollment dated

at New York July 2<sup>d</sup> 1847. and numbered Seventy one  
71. Now said and having changed name,

And the said Enrollment having certified that  
the said Propeller or Vessel has One Mast and Two Masts, and that  
her length is One hundred and thirty five feet and three inches  
her breadth Twenty four feet and ten inches  
her depth Eight feet and one inch  
and that she measures One hundred & fifty six tons thirty nine  
that she is a Propeller has ninety-fifths;

And the said Lucian M. Smith and head  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been  
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly  
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
