In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

And St. John, of the City of New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Steam Boat, or Vessel, called the Empire whereof Henry Randall

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1844 as appears by the Record of her Enrollment dated at this port 13th July, 1848, and numbered sixty (60) recorded in page 135, in Book of Enrollments at this port; said Enrollment having been lost, as appears by Affidavit of And St. John, on file in this office.

And the said Record of Enrollment having certified that

the said Steam Boat, or Vessel has Two Decks and One Mast, and that

her length is Two hundred and fifty three feet and six inches 253ft. 6 in

her breadth Thirty two feet eight and one half inches 32 " 8 1/2 "

her depth Fifteen feet and two inches 14 " 2 "

and that she measures Clear hundred and forty seven tons Seventy Two ninety-fifths;

that she is a Steam Boat has no gallery

and rigue head

And the said having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been

given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly

Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
