In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

Jacob W Banta of Buffalo Erie County New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Benjamin Bidwell, of Buffalo New York Vincent Bidwell of Buffalo New York and Pardon S Sherman of Buffalo New York

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the Emerald whereof Oliver Palmer is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Charleston Ohio in the year 1844 as appears by her Enrollment dated at this Port the twentieth day of July 1848 and numbered sixty three (63) and now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one Deck and two masts, and that her length is One Hundred and one feet & Six inches (101ft 6 inches) her breadth twenty two feet & two 1/2 inches (22 ft 2 1/2 inches) her depth is Eight feet and eight inches (8 ft 8 inches) and that she measures One Hundred & Eighty five tons forty ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig has no gallery a Square Stern and a Scroll head

And the said Jacob W Banta, having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
