In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Emdy is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Richmond City, Ohio in the year 1848 as appears by the Enrollment dated Sept. 5 1848 and numbered 88 Eighty Eight Crew numbered having changed owned And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Steamboat or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is One hundred and fifty eight feet and five inches 158 ft 5 in her breadth Twenty seven feet and six inches 27 ft 6 in her depth Seven feet and six inches 7 ft 6 in and that she measures Four hundred twenty two tons forty one ninety-fifths; that she is a Steam Boat has No gallies head

And the said George W. Holt and James M. Emdy having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
