In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Wilson Parker of Buffalo N. York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is  
 together with  
 Aaron Root of Huron Ohio  
 and Alexander and John S. McElwain, Milan O,  
 an

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the  
 Horner  
 is at present Master; and as he hath John Prady, sworn  
 is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black  
 River Ohio in the year 1848 as appears by her Enrollment  
 dated at the Port of Sandusky Ohio September 14th 1848  
 and numbered (VIA) Twenty four  
 Now denuded having changed owner.

And the said Enrollment having certified that  
 the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two Masts and that  
 her length is Eighty seven feet Seven inches 87ft 7in  
 her breadth Thirteen feet and Nine inches 13ft 9in  
 her depth Seven feet Seven inches 7ft 7in  
 and that she measures One hundred thirteen tons of forty ninety-fifths;  
 that she is a Schooner has a

And the said Wilson Parker and Scroll head  
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been  
 given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly  
 Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
