In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833. Smith Coman of Buffalo N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Tench C. Stiles of Buffalo N.Y. an

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller or Vessel, called the *Ogontz* whereof George N. Hands is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City, State of Ohio in the year 1848 as appears by her enrollment dated at the Port of Sandusky Ohio October 16. 1848 and numbered Twenty nine (29) now surrounded having changed owner

And the said enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is one hundred and fifty two feet and seven inches 152-7 her breadth Twenty two feet and one and one half inches 22-9 1/2 her depth Ten feet three and one half inches 10 3/2 and that she measures Three hundred forty three tons thirty seven ninety-fifths; that she is a Propeller has one wheel and no head

And the said Smith Coman having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
