In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

 having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

 is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
 is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester
 New York in the year 1848 as appears by the Certificate of Walter
 B. Smith, of Port Jervis, as appears by his Certificate, now on file in this office &
 Edwin Hubbard, Surveyor of this Port. and

And the said Francis Cunningham, by his said Attorney, having certified that
 the said Canal Boat or Vessel has One Deck and _____ and that
 her length is Seventy Nine feet _____ 79 ft
 her breadth fifteen feet and one inch _____ 14 ft 1 in
 her depth Six feet eleven inches _____ 6 ft 11 in
 and that she measures Sixty one tons & fifteen ninety-fifths;
 that she is a Canal Boat has _____ and _____ head
