In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

George B. Walbridge of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel, called the Accumbah whereof John E. Hoff is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Algona, Michigan in the year 1845, as appears by Her Enrollment dated at this port April 17th 1849 and Number 29, Twenty Nine Now numbered having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Steamboat or Vessel has One Deck and her length is One hundred & thirty nine feet and three inches her breadth Twenty feet and two inches her depth Three feet and four inches and that she measures Two hundred & eighty five tons sixty feet ninety fifts; that she is a Steam Boat and head

And the said George B. Walbridge having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
