Robinson is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland Ohio in the year 1844 as appears by the Enrollment dated at that port October 30th 1848 and amended eight days (185), now amended having changed owner.

And the said Enrollments having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and two masts and that her length is One hundred & nine feet, and eleven inches 109, 11 her breadth Twenty four feet & two inches 24, 2 her depth Nine feet and nine inches 9, 9 and that she measures Two hundred thirty six tons sixty three ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has

And the said Charles G. Richmond a scroll head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
