And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is thirty two feet and six inches 92 ft 6 in her breadth twenty two feet and nine inches 22 ft 9 in her depth eight feet and three inches 8 ft 3 in and that she measures One hundred fifty five tons twenty four ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner

And the said Daniel S. Watson and his wife having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
