In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Emmanuel N. Prindle, Managing owner, of Buffalo, New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with

The Estate of William B. Allen, of Black Rock, Erie Co. N.Y.
Abner Stone, of Black Rock, Erie County, N.Y.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the "Trident" whereof Wm. S. Sheatt, of Cleveland, Ohio, is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment; date at this Port October 25th 1849, and Numbered Twenty four (24).
