Sheldon, of Buffalo, N.Y. is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Monroe, Michigan in the year 1847, as appears by her Enrollment, dated at this Port, May 17, 1848, and Numbered, 381 Thirty Eight, now Surrendered having Change of owners.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is One hundred & fifteen feet Ten inches 115ft. 10in her breadth Twenty five feet Nine and One half inches 24 " 9 1/2 " her depth Nine feet and five inches 9 " 5 " and that she measured Two hundred & forty eight tons Nine ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig and head

And the said Henry Roof and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
