In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

her breadth Twenty three feet six inches 23 " 6 "

her depth Eight feet six inches 8 " 6 "

and that she measures One hundred forty four tons three ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner and has

and a scroll head And the said James L. Watson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly

Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
