In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

Gibson T. Williams, of Buffalo, Erie County, New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the Preble, whereof Gibson T. Williams,

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1842, as appears by her Enrollment, dated

at this Port August 15th 1842, Numbered Forty (40) and now surrendered having changed owner

And the said Enrollment, having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Ninety Seven feet and Nine inches 97 ft 9 in. her breadth Twenty Six feet 26 " 8" her depth Nine feet and eight inches 9 " 8" and that she measures Three hundred & seventeen tons Thirty Tons ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig has no gallery and a Scull head

And the said head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
