In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Brig* or Vessel, called the *Irvington* whereof *Crestus H. Ferris* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *White Haven*, in the year 1835 as appears by her Enrollment, dated

*At New York December 5th 1848, and Numbered Ninety Two (92) New York*

And the said Enrollment, having changed name to the said *Brig* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Eighty Two feet and five inches* *82 feet 5 in* her breadth *Twenty feet and Two inches* *20 . 2 .* her depth *Eight feet and Ten inches* *8 10 .* and that she measures *One hundred and Twenty Nine tons* *Seventy Six* *ninety-fifths;* that she is a *Brig* and *Billot* head having

And the said *Crestus H. Ferris* agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
