In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838;

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Washington Irving whereof John A. Field, is at present Master; and as he hath sworn Ohio in the year 1844 as appears by the Enrollment dated

at this port July 15th 1847, numbered 7th New numbered having changed

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One deck and Two Masts and that her length is Eighty One feet and one inch 81 ft 1 in her breadth Ninety feet four and a half inches 90 " 1 1/2 her depth Seven feet seven and a half inches 7 " 7 1/2 and that she measures One hundred & Eleven tons fifty four ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has No. gallery and a Square Stern head

And the said William Buckley having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
