In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

Henry C. Walker of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Virginia C. Bristol & Henry P. Garrow of the same place & Isaac C. Walker of Milan Ohio

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel, called the *Ogontz* whereof George N. Spencer is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City, Ohio in the year 1848 as appears by her Enrollment dated

at this Port October 23, 1849 and numbered ninety six (96) (which said Enrollment is lost as per afft on file in this office)

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two Decks and one Mast and that her length is One hundred & fifty two feet seven inches 152-7 her breadth Twenty two feet nine & a half inches 22-9 1/2 her depth Ten feet three & one half inches 10-3 1/2 and that she measures Three hundred forty three tons thirty seven ninety-fifths; that she is a Propeller has one wheel

and no head And the said Henry C. Walker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
