And the said Enrollment, having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one Deck and two masts and that her length is six hundred and seven feet and four inches 117 feet H^m her breadth Twenty five feet and nine inches 24 9 her depth Six feet and eight inches 9 8 and that she measures Two hundred and fifty eight tons + nine ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig has a scroll

And the said Samuel F. Pratt and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
