Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel, called the Fashion whereof Samuel Wood of Buffalo N.Y. is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
This Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan in the year 1847 as appears by his last enrollment dated

at Sandusky Ohio the nineteenth day of October one thousand eight hundred and forty eight and numbered thirty / 30 /

And the said enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is One hundred and eight feet 108 ft her breadth Twenty three feet and ten inches 23. 10 in her depth Nine feet and six inches 9. 6. and that she measures two hundred and thirty three tons thirty five ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has a square stern and square head

And the said Henry C. Walker having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
