In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, *John Jones, Jr.* Managing owner, of Hamburg, Erie County, New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a ~~together with~~ *together with* ~~James~~ *James*, of the same place.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the "*Stranger*" whereof *George Mow*, of Hamburg, Erie Co. N.Y. is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan China in the year 1813 as appears by her Enrollment, dated

at this Port, April 23^d 1844, and Numbered 17, Seventeen, New Surrendered *having* ~~Change~~ *Change* ~~Owner~~

And the said Enrollment *having certified that* the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Eighty six feet* *86 feet* her breadth *Twenty feet and Two inches* *20 . 2 in* her depth *Seven feet and Eleven inches* *7 . 11 "* and that she measures *One hundred Twenty four tons Ninety two* *ninety-fifths;* that she is a *Schooner* *has No Hull up* and a *Scull* *head*

And the said *John Jones, Jr.* *having* agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
