Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the *William Brickley* whereof

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Irving*

New York, in the year 1849 as appears by the Enrollment dated at this port the thirteenth day of October 1849,

and numbered (921) *Twenty two*

And the said Enrollment having certified that

the said Schooner or Vessel has *One deck* and *two masts* and that

her length is *Eighty seven feet and five inches* 8 1/2 ft - 5 in

her breadth *Nineteen feet & one half inch* 19 ft - 1 1/2 in

her depth *Six feet & one half inch* 6 ft - 1 1/2 in

and that she measures *Twenty nine* tons *Sixty one* ninety-fifths;

that she is a *Schooner* and has a *Square* *Stem* head

And the said *Clark* *Swift* having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been

given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly

Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
