In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers, on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Charles H. Rogers of Buffalo New York

Enrolled at this port, this 7th day of January 1851. And now paper of said being changed owned.

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel, called the "Master Oak" whereof Charles H. Rogers is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1847, as appears by the Enrollment

dated at this port May September 5th 1848 & Number (76) Twenty Six, New York and having changed owned And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One No. 10 and Two Masts and that her length is One hundred & four feet & six inches 104 ft 5 in her breadth Twenty two feet & one half inch 22 ft 3/2 her depth Eight feet & one half inch 8 ft 1/2 and that she measures One hundred & Eighty four tons Twenty four ninety-fifths; that she is a Propeller and a Stern head

And the said Andel R. Cobb having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
