In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled, in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Thomas A. Mead, of Greenwich, Connecticut, Sole owner,
by his attorney Anatio Seymour, of Buffalo, New York,
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the
"Blue Bell" whereof Niel Bond,
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn,
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Aurora
Ohio in the year 1844, as appears by her Enrollment, dated

at this Port, December 15, 1848, and Numbered Ninety three (93) Numbered
under, having changed name.

And the said Enrollment having certified that
the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts, and that
her length is Thirty feet and six inches 9 feet 6 in
her breadth Twenty Two feet and Two inches 22 " 2 "
her depth Six feet and four inches 8 " 4 "
and that she measures One hundred fifty tons Sixteen ninety-fifths;
that she is a Schooner has

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
