Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schoon or Vessel, called the Otina whereof Myron Gage is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Silen Co. N.Y. in 1841 and rebuilt in the year 1843 as appears by Her Enrolment dated

At the Port of Detroit Michigan June 24, 1848 numbered 30. Her name Otina having changed name to Otina And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Schoon or Vessel has One deck and Two masts and that her length is Eighty four feet seven inches 84 ft 7 in her breadth Eighteen feet four inches 19 ft 4 in her depth Six feet four inches 6 ft 4 in and that she measures Twenty one tons ninety-fifths; that she is a Schoon, has No galley and No head

And the said Myron Gage having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schoon has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
