



# ENROLLMENT.

In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833.

*P. C. Russell* of Syracuse NY Managing owner  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is  
together with *John Kirkwood, Hamilton White, & H. Willington*  
of Syracuse, N.Y. a Member of *Wheeler, M. & P.*  
*Brick of Chicago Illinois & John Smith* an

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Steam Boat or Vessel, called the  
*Rossuth* whereof *Theodor Quackenbush*  
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn  
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ferrisburgh*  
*New York* in the year 1850 as appears by the certificate of  
*Henry A. Chase* Master dated at this port  
*May seventh 1850.* and on file in this office

And *John Smith* having certified that  
the said Steam Boat or Vessel has *One deck* and *One Mast* and that  
her length is *Ninety seven feet*  
her breadth *Eighteen feet and eight inches* 18 " 8 in  
her depth *Seven feet and no inches* 7 " 0 "  
and that she measures *One hundred and Eighteen tons* 118 tons  
that she is a *Steam Boat* and has *no* head

And the said *P. C. Russell* and *a* head  
having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been  
given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steamboat has been duly  
Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
