In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

James Parker, of Buffalo, Erie County, N.Y. Managing owner,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with *Nancy Chase*
R. Louis Chase, of Milan, Ohio, and
Crastus Scuttle, of Buffalo, New York owners

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the *Athaca*, whereof *Crastus Scuttle* is at present Master; and as he hath sworn, is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan in the State of Ohio. in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at *Seneca*, 25 October 1847, and Numbered *Thirty Eight (38) Nor* Sun ended, having changed Districts.

And the said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two masts* and that her length is *One hundred and Seven feet and Seven inches* 107 feet 11 in her breadth *Twenty three feet Ten inches* 23 " 10 in her depth *Eight feet Six inches* 8 " 6 in and that she measures *One hundred Ninety Nine tons* *forty three* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has her name and place painted on her Stern and *Side* head

And the said *James Parker* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
