In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, Israel D. Hatch, of Buffalo, New York, Sole owner,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel, called the August Belmont, whereof Charles Reese is at present Master; and as he hath sworn,

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at this City in the State of Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment, dated

at this port, the 17 day of August, 1848, and Number Seventy One (71), now renamed, having changed names,

And the said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts, and that her length is One hundred and Twenty feet and Nine inches 120ft 9in her breadth Twenty One feet and three inches 21 " 3 1/2 her depth Eight feet Seven and One half inches 8 " 7 1/2 and that she measures Three hundred & Eight tons thirty four, ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has

And the said Israel D. Hatch head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner, has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
