In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833,

William Sutton, of Buffalo, New York, Managing owner,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with George Davis, and Jacob Worcester, of Buffalo, New York,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Propeller or Vessel, called the *Pohahantus*, whereof Jacob Worcester, is at present Master; and as he hath sworn, is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, New York in the year 1846 as appears by her Enrollment, dated

at this Port, May 5th 1846, and Minibaud Thirtyseven (S.P. Minibaud), having changed name

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One Deck and one mast, and that her length is One hundred and twenty eight feet and Nine inches 171. 9. her breadth Twenty four feet and Eleven inches 24. 11. her depth Ten feet four and one half inches 10. 4 1/2 and that she measures four hundred and twenty seven tons Sixty five ninety-fifths; that she is a Propeller and no figure

And the said William Sutton head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
