the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck, and Two Masts, and that
her length is One hundred and fourteen feet & 10 inches 114, 10
her breadth Twenty five feet and three inches 25, 3
her depth Three feet and three inches 3, 3
and that she measures Two hundred Forty five tons and Seven ninety-fifths;
that she is a Schooner has a Square Stern, and a Figure head

And the said Daniel O. Reed having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
