In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, Robert Mills of Tonawanda, New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Moses Cherry of Tonawanda, New York, Sebastian W. Falcott, & Gustavus P. Kosman of Albany, New York, and

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel, called the J. P. Pratt whereof Robert Mills is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1848 as appears by her Enrollment, dated

at this Port, 27 May 1849, Numbered fifty, New-Lenawend, having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck, and Two Masts, and that her length is One hundred and fourteen feet and one inch 114 ft. 1 in her breadth Twenty One feet and one half inch 21 " 1/2 her depth Eight feet and Nine inches 8 " 9 and that she measures One Hundred ninety Six tons Sixty ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has a screw

And the said Robert Mills having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
