In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Serome Benhydt, of Rochester, N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or Vessel, called the N. W. Gardner whereof Serome Benhydt is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester in the year 1849 as appears by the Certificate of the

Shipwright, dated June 17, 1857, and now on file in this office

And Succin Hawley Sawyer having certified that the said Canal Boat or Vessel has one Deck and no masts and that her length is seventy eight feet, nine inches 78ft. 9in her breadth thirteen feet, and three inches 13. 3. her depth eight feet and four inches 8. 4. and that she measures Eighty Tons tons Sixteen ninety-fifths; that she is a Canal Boat has a knife and head

And the said Serome Benhydt having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
