In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is to gather into, John Steward of Berlin, Milan, Aaron Root of Berlin, and Samuel Harrison of Toledo Ohio -

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel, called the *Navy Clay* whereof Aaron Root is at present Master, and as he hath sworn -

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1849 as appears by the Enrollment dated at this port May March 1849, and Number forty six (46) Now included having changed owner,

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has One Wick and One Mast, and that her length is One hundred and seven feet and six inches 107ft 6in her breadth Twenty two feet seven and One half inches 22ft 7 1/2in her depth Nine feet and Eleven inches 9ft 11in and that she measures Two hundred Twenty one tons Twenty eight ninety-fifths; that she is a Propeller and has

And the said George W. Decker and head having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
