In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833,

George B. Walbridge, of Buffalo, N.Y., Managing owner,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is together with Jacob Worcester, of the same place,

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller or Vessel, called the Saccharas whereof Jacob Worcester, is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo, New York in the year 1846 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at this Port, May 14, 1857, and numbered (37) Thirty Seven, now Surrendered, having changed owners

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has one Deck and one mast, and that her length is One hundred and seventy one feet and nine inches 171 ft 9. her breadth Twenty four feet and Eleven inches 24. 11 her depth Ten feet four and one half inches 10. 4 1/2 and that she measures from her main and mizzenmast sixty four ninety-fifths; that she is a Propeller, has

and no figure head And the said George B. Walbridge having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller, has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
