at this port April Eleventh 1849, and amended January 20.

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has one Deck and two Masts and that her length is One hundred & four feet and Eight inches 104 ft 8 in her breadth Twenty three feet and one inch 23 " 1 her depth Eight feet Six and one half inches 8 " 3 1/2 and that she measures One hundred & Eighty four tons Ninety nine ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig and No. 73

And the said David L. Potts and Charles C. Potts having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
