In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833,
Dinn Hulser, of Frankfort, Herkimer County New York,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or Vessel, called the
S. W. L. Herald, whereof Dinn Hulser
is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Millport
Chemung Co. N.Y. in the year 1846 as appears by the Certificate of R.
Masier, Builder, and D. Hulser, Master, now on file in this office.

And the Edw in Hubbert, Surveyor, having certified that
the said Canal Boat or Vessel has one Mast and Masts, and that
her length is Seventy Nine feet 79ft
her breadth Fourteen feet 14ft
her depth five feet and eight inches 11.8ft
and that she measures fully two tons and 6 (Six) ninety-fifths;
