having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat or Vessel, called the May 19 Brumby whereof Levi Stearns is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester New York in the year 1846 as appears by the certificate of Seth,

G. J. Masten Builder dated 1850 Now on file in this Office;

And the R. C. and W. J. Stearns having certified that the said Canal Boat or Vessel has One Deck and that her length is Seventy nine feet and eight inches 49 ft 8 in her breadth Thirteen feet and six inches 13. 6. her depth Five feet and three inches 5. 3. and that she measures Fifty three tons Thirty seven ninety-fifths; that she is a Canal Boat has One Deck and no head

And the said J. J. Tallmadge having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat, has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
