Petrel of Buffalo, whereof Seremiah C. Oliver is at present Master; and as he hath sworn
is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo
New York in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment, dated

at this Port, 17th April 1847, and Numbered Seventeen (17), now being ready to receive cargo and passengers
And the said Enrollment, having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one Deck and Iron masts, and that her length is one hundred thirteen feet and six inches 113 ft. 6 in her breadth Twenty three feet and four inches 23 ft. 4 in her depth Eight feet six and one half inches 8 ft. 6 1/2 in and that she measures one hundred and eighty seven tons seventy one ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner and has a screw head

And the said Seremiah C. Oliver having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
