In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 13th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes, passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Lucius H. Pratt, of Buffalo, New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with H. P. Sackett, of Sandusky, Ohio, are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig or Vessel, called the Castalia, of Buffalo, whereof Heavisaw P. Sackett is at present Master; and as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sandusky Ohio, in the year 1847 as appears by her Enrollment, dated at the Port of Sandusky, Ohio, August 27<sup>th</sup> 1849, and numbered 24, New York and no, having changed names

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or Vessel has One Deck and Two masts and that her length is one hundred and Nineteen feet 119 ft her breadth Twenty-five feet and three inches 25 3/4 her depth Eight feet and Nine inches 8 9/4 and that she measures Two hundred forty one tons Eighty Two ninety-fifths; that she is a Brig has a Square Stern and a Scroll head

And the said Lucius H. Pratt having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
