In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

Straw Niles of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is the owner of an equal undivided half part of the Propeller Monticello and Lucius Pratt of the same place is the owner of the other equal undivided half part of said Propeller that said Straw Niles & Lucius Pratt are

Citizen of the United States, and ^{sole} owner of the Propeller ^{or Vessel called the} Monticello ^{whereof John Wilson}

is at present Master; and as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Fairport.

This in the year 1848 as appears by her certificate of enrollment dated at Cleveland Ohio the 20th day of February 1848. and numbered (B) and now surrounded having changed owner

And the said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or Vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is One hundred and fifty one feet and nine inches 151. ft 9 in her breadth Thirty feet four inches 20 " 4 " her depth Ten feet two inches 10 " 2 " and that she measures 364 tons eight ninety-fifths that she is a Steamer Propeller has a round stern and a tillitt head

And the said Straw Niles having agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, she said has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
