In conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c., passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to Regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern, and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1834; and "An Act to provide for the better security of the lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, also an Act, entitled "An Act to provide for recording the conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes" passed July 29, 1850.

John P. Smith of Buffalo New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Charles W. Smith and Abel B. Smith both of the said City of Buffalo N.Y. are the owners of the brig hereinafter named and that they each own an equal undivided third thereof and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and <sup>owner</sup> of the Brig <sup>or Vessel</sup> called the *Preble* whereof John Preble of Buffalo N.Y.

is at present Master, and as he hath sworn — is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo New York in the year 1842 as appears by her enrollment dated at this port March 11th 1850. and ~~was~~ <sup>is</sup> now ~~owned~~ <sup>owned</sup> and having changed owners

And the said Enrollment <sup>having certified that</sup> the said Brig <sup>or Vessel</sup> has one Deck and two masts and that her length is ninety seven feet and nine inches (97 ft 9 in) her breadth Twenty six feet (26 ft) her depth nine feet and eight inches (9 " 8") and that she measures Two hundred & seven customs Thirty two ninety-fifths. that she is a Brig has no Gallies and a scroll head

And the said John P. Smith <sup>having</sup> agreed to the description and admeasurements above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo.
